

On behalf of the foundation board of trustees, I would like to extend my sincerest appreciation. It has been my pleasure to serve.

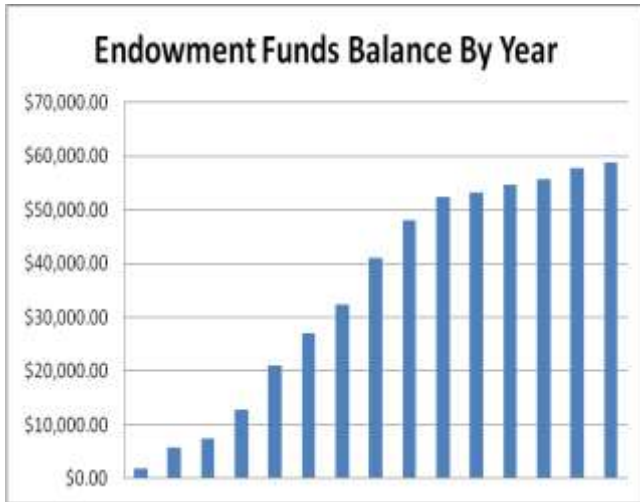
